

**CITY OF PERTH AMBOY
NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

Sealed bids will be received by the Purchasing Department for the City of Perth Amboy on **Wednesday, August 5, 2026, at 1:00 P.M.** prevailing time in the Council Chambers, City Hall, 260 High Street, Perth Amboy, NJ 08861 at which time and place bids will be opened and read in public for:

Stormwater Curb Extension Implementation Project at Various Locations

The scope of Work contemplated for the above-named project includes Installation of new rain gardens at the intersections of Cornell Street & Barclay Street; Cornell Street & Compton Street; Cornell Street & Lawrie Street; Cornell Street & Neville Street; and Jefferson Street & Madison Avenue. Each intersection has its individual design with demolition of existing features, installation of new drainage pipes, structures and backfill, curb, sidewalk, landscaping, fencing, as well as all other work of any type or description necessary for completion of the project, whether or not specifically described in these Contract Documents. All Work on this Contract shall be completed within one hundred twenty (120) Calendar Days from Notice to Proceed.

The Purchasing Division encourages vendors to mail in their bid responses in a timely manner via USPS, UPS and FedEx, etc. If they must be hand-delivered, potential bidders may drop them off at the **Business Administration Office** located on the 2nd Floor. Enter through the Market Street Entrance of the City Hall Building, 260 High Street, Perth Amboy, New Jersey 08861 and proceed to the second Floor.

The bid opening will be conducted in person in the Council Chambers. During the bid opening process, the bidders will be announced as well as bid amounts. A bid review providing unit prices will not take place at the openings. Instead, this information will be posted, as always, to the Purchasing webpage once available.

Bid responses must be made on the standard proposal forms, be enclosed in a sealed package and one (1) digital version (USB) bearing the name and address of the bidder and the "Stormwater Curb Extension Implementation Project at Various Locations" on the outside, and addressed to Alma Benavides, Purchasing Assistant, at the address above.

Any Bid Addenda will be issued on the City's website and processed in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23(c)(1). All interested bidders should check the website from now through bid opening. It is the sole responsibility of the respondent to be knowledgeable of all addenda related to this procurement.

Contract Documents, Specification and instructions to bidders (prepared by Antonios Panagopoulos, PE, of T&M Associates) and Plans (prepared by Christopher C. Obropta, Ph.D., P.E., of Rutgers University Water Resources Program) for the proposed Work, which have been, may be obtained at the Purchasing Office or the City's website at www.perthamboynj.org.

The provided Bid Packet must be completed in the manner designated in the Contract Documents. Bid submissions must be accompanied by a Statement of Consent of Surety from a surety company holding a Certificate of Authorization to do business in the State of New Jersey and either a Bid Bond or a Certified Check drawn to the order of "City of Perth Amboy" for not less than ten percent (10%) of the total bid price amount, except that the check shall not exceed \$20,000.00. The successful Bidder is hereby notified that a Performance and Payment Bond for the full amount of this Project is required.

The award of the Contract for this Project will not be made until the necessary funds have been provided by City of Perth Amboy in a lawful manner. Please be advised that this Project is being funded through the City of Perth Amboy. By virtue of Executive Order #34 (1976), vendors currently suspended, debarred or disqualified are excluded from participating on this Project.

The successful Bidder shall be required to comply with the applicable statutory requirements of the Contract Documents and Plans which include all of the following: (i) **N.J.A.C. 17:27**; (ii) **N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq.**; (iii) **Business Registrations** (N.J.S.A. 52:32-44); (iv) **Prevailing Wage Act** (N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.25, et seq.); (v) **Public Work Contractor Registration** (N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.48); and (vi) **Affirmative Action Requirements** (N.J.S.A. 10:5-1, et seq.); and any other legal requirements applicable to this Project.

City of Perth Amboy intends to award this Project to the lowest responsible and responsive Bidder in accordance with applicable law. City of Perth Amboy reserves the right to reject any and all Bids to the extent permitted by law. An award will be made or Bids will be rejected within sixty (60) Calendar Days after the electronic opening of the Bids, during which time the Bids shall be irrevocable and unavailable to withdraw by Bidders, unless otherwise extended in the Contract Documents.

The contract shall not be approved until a favorable eligibility determination has been made by the New Jersey Department of Transportation.
